**Temporary Moratorium On Off Premise Signage
Resolution 2011-2**

The Town Board of the Town of Namakagon, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

To provide time for due consideration of an ordinance to regulate the placement, size and location of off premise signs in the town the following shall be adhered to:

Consistent with ss 60.29 (29) and ss 86.19 the Town of Namakagon will consider an ordinance to regulate signs and bill boards in the town.

- There shall be a six month moratorium on the approval of all off premise signs, bill boards and the like. The moratorium shall commence from the date of the adoption of this resolution. The only exception will be temporary signs such as signs for real estate sales and special events with the approval of the Town Chairman.
- Any violation of this resolution shall result in a fine not to exceed \$1,000 plus the cost of removal of the identified sign, if necessary.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
