BURNING PERMITS: Permits are required for burning barrels and open burning. Permits and information on burning restrictions may be obtained from Henry Rieckhoff at Mogasheen Resort (715-794-2113), Ted Green at transfer site (715-794-2644) or home (715-794-2188), and Rondeau's store (715-798-3211). FIREWORKS PERMITS: A permit is required for fireworks and may only be obtained from the Town Clerk. State law requires notification of the issuance of the permit to law enforcement two days prior to the effective date on the permit.
