

ORDINANCE No. 47

CLERK POSITION - ELECTED TO APPOINTED

The Town Board of the Town of Namakagon, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

The term of office for the appointed position shall be set by the town board, for a term of 3 years per § 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for cause as defined under § 17.001 and required by § 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on, November 6, 2018 the next General Election. The referendum question shall be:

The Town Clerk in the Town of Namakagon, Bayfield County Wisconsin be appointed by the Town Board.

The salary of the appointed position shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per § 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by § 60.30(1e)(b).

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the Town Clerk shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.
