Winter Hours: Oct. 16 – April 30, Wed. & Sat 1 - 4 p.m.

Summer Hours: May 1 – October 15, Mon. & Wed. 1 - 5 p.m., and Sat. 9 - 5 p.m.

From April 1 to October 30 a container will be at the transfer site (715-794-2644) for disposal of furniture and mattresses. Almost everything may be disposed of at the transfer site. Please separate aluminum cans from other recyclables.

BURNING PERMITS: Permits are required for burning barrels and open burning. Permits and information on burning restrictions may be obtained from Henry Rieckhoff at Mogasheen Resort (715-794-2113), transfer site (715-794-2644) and Rondeau's store (715-798-3211). FIREWORKS PERMITS: A permit is required for each day that fireworks are to be used, and only for the date issued on the permit. State law requires notification of the issuance of the permit to law enforcement two days prior to the effective date on the permit. Permits may only be obtained from the Town Clerk.
