Report to Towns

- Work is complete on the fireplace part of our fireplace renovation. We still await the arrival and installation of the actual fireplace insert. When that arrives, well, we're just going to have to have a cookies and cocoa day! We'll keep you posted!
- We continue to make slow progress on our Facility Development project. Our committee met in late January to discuss several suggested options for the connecting corridor between the log cabin and the building to be. We ended up choosing Option B, the one most strongly recommended by Keller Builds, and which involves a 10 foot set-back from the property line, and, thus, no masonry firewall at that boundary. We will formalize our recommendation with a vote from the full Library Board at our meeting on Feb. 13.
- Our next meeting with Keller Builds is scheduled for Tuesday, March 12<sup>th</sup>. At that time we should get a first look at the actual building plan! There will, of course, be more than one meeting on this subject and we will hope and plan to include a public input session at one of these meetings. Again...we'll keep you posted!
- The library hosted a Candidate's Forum in Cable which gave area voters an opportunity to hear from the three current candidates for the Town Chair position. We were pleased to have nearly 60 people in attendance and are, also, grateful to the candidates for providing the citizenry this opportunity to hear about their positions on local issues.
- Director Lendved took advantage of the Wild Wisconsin Winter Web Conference, offered by a group of state library systems, including our own. Sessions on marketing, programming and customer service were among the offerings.
- The GET A CLUE book club, our partnership effort with Redbery Books, met on 1/22 to talk about Allen Eskens' THE LIFE WE BURY. Our next scheduled meeting is Tues, March 19<sup>th</sup> and we'll be reading THE RUIN by Dervla McTiernan. This IS an open club, so, if you or anyone you know enjoys mysteries and crime fiction, you are welcome to join a good group for great discussions.
- We have had a few closures due to weather. We were open half a day on Feb. 7 and are technically closed on the day of this writing, Feb. 12, although a few brave souls have ventured in to find Director Lendved getting caught up on a few things.
