

COVID-19 Testing Increasing in Northwestern Wisconsin

National Guard Assists Northwestern Wisconsin in increasing testing for persons with COVID-19 like symptoms.

Testing will be done using a drive-through collection process. Vehicles should enter Business 53 from the north and line up while waiting for drive-up testing.

People should remain in their cars.

People who are 5 years of age or older and are currently sick with the following symptoms are eligible for nasal swab testing:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Chills or repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Vomiting or nausea

This is a test to determine if you currently have COVID-19 disease. Testing through the collection site will be free of cost and is only available to Wisconsin residents, including residents of other Wisconsin counties. The goal is to test up to 250 people throughout the day.
