

COVID-19 Testing Increasing in Northwestern Wisconsin

Wisconsin National Guard Assists Northwestern Wisconsin in increasing testing for persons with COVID-19-like symptoms.

Testing will be done using a drive-through collection process. Vehicles should line up while waiting for drive-up testing according to flaggers directing traffic. People should remain in their cars for testing.

People who are 5 years of age or older and have **ANY** of the following symptoms are eligible for **FREE** nasal swab testing:

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Vomiting or nausea
- Headache
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Chills or repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Runny nose/congestion

This is a test to determine if you have current COVID-19 illness. Testing at the National Guard testing site will be **FREE** of cost and is available to Wisconsin residents (from ANY county) or if you work in or live seasonally in Wisconsin. The goal is to test at least 300 people throughout the day.
