| Alarm               | # 42      | Any homeowner whose alarm system causes safety personnel to the residence and it is a false alarm will be subject to the charges. It is the owner's obligation to keep the driveway clear to town standards (see Town Ordinance #47 Driveways) and accessible at all times. Any expense involved in clearing and gaining access to a driveway that is not clear will be the obligation of the owner.
