Thank you for the 2020 Hunter's Dinner donations! Your donations for both the Namakagon Volunteer Fire Department and the Namakagon Community Club were greatly appreciated. The Fire Department continues to save for an Ultra High-Pressure System. This system is number one on their priority list. Funds for the Community Club were used to support numerous local organizations. Donors received a "Thank You" note last year which included a tax donation letter. The Fire Department will continue to send a tax letter for donations received, however, funds donated to the Community Club are not tax deductible.

This year, due to COVID, the Fire Department was unable to host its annual pancake breakfast and the Community Club will not be able to host the Hunter's Dinner. We are, however, still asking for your support for our volunteer Fire Department and Community Club. Your support is greatly appreciated as the Fire Department saves for new equipment to support the community and the Community Club supports multiple organizations including the Fire Department. Donations, to the Fire Department, have allowed the department to maintain nearly the same operating budget for the last 3 years!

To date, Fire Department personnel have responded to 17 incidents. On June 12, 2021, they held their open house and fire extinguisher service. At this time 164 fire extinguishers were checked and serviced, free of charge, to any and all community members. Please mark your calendars for Saturday, June 11, 2022! This is the tentative date for the next Namakagon Volunteer Fire Department Open House. Bring in your fire extinguisher for free service or purchase a new fire extinguisher from Protective Services.
