

**TOWN OF NAMAKAGON**  
**For - TOWN BOARD WORK MEETING–Monday, October 10, 2022**  
**At - NAMAKAGON TOWN HALL – 10 a.m.**  
**MINUTES**

Chairman Rasmussen called the meeting to order at 10:04am. Present were Chairman Rasmussen, Supervisors Jack McGregor and Jim Krueger, Treasurer Arlene Skultety and Clerk Laura Bjork.

**2023 Budget** – There was discussion on the increase in subsidy request from Great Divide Ambulance Service. The ambulance budget was presented, and it was noted that the ambulance is currently unsustainable using funds from savings to balance their budget and 3 loans. The updated town budget was reviewed. There was a surplus of \$7,165.50 on the presented budget. There was discussion on purchasing an election machine and outdoor lighting on the west side of the Town Hall.

MOTION made by Supervisor Krueger to go into Closed Session at 10:50am pursuant to S.19.85(1)(c) of the WI Statutes for considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the Governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. The board will reconvene in open session to take necessary action as required and resume regular town business. MOTION seconded by Supervisor McGregor and carried.

MOTION made by Supervisor McGregor at 11:10am to reconvene in open session to take necessary action as required and resume regular town business. MOTION seconded by Supervisor Krueger and carried.

The board agreed to increase the treasurer's salary, budget for wages for Short Term Rentals (which funds from Room Tax funds) and the rest of the outstanding surplus to go towards the unknown increase in health insurance in May.

Chairman Rasmussen adjourned at 11:15am.
