BURNING PERMITS: Permits are required for burning barrels and open burning. Permits and information on burning restrictions may be obtained from Henry Rieckhoff at Mogasheen Resort (715-794-2113), transfer site (715-794-2644) and Rondeau's store (715-798-3211). Yearly permits are available on-line at Wisconsin DNR: <https://dnr.wi.gov/burnpermits/>, or call 1-888-WIS-BURN (947-2876).

FIREWORKS PERMITS: A permit is required for each day that fireworks are to be used, and only for the date issued on the permit. State law requires notification of the issuance of the permit to law enforcement two days prior to the effective date on the permit. **Permits may only be obtained from the Town Clerk.**
