Your gracious support, added to past funds, allowed the Namakagon Fire Department to purchase a Ford F250 truck and an ultra-high-pressure fire suppression system. In addition, the Community Club supported 14 local organizations. All donations stayed within the community and from all of us to all of you, thank you.

As we enter the heating-season remember to check your smoke alarms and CO2 monitors. Safety first! The fire department's goal, this year, is to purchase battery powered extrication equipment. The department has applied for a grant, but have not heard if it will be awarded. The gear has a total cost of \$31,000. Your donations will go towards these items.

When in the area stop in and have dinner with the Community Club. We get together monthly (September-May) on the first Thursday at 6:00 P.M., at the Town Hall; new members are always welcome. We regret to inform you that we have decided not to host the Hunter's Dinner. Over the years the numbers served have decreased and we feel that we can serve the community with our monthly meetings and various events we support.
