## **Library Expansion Update:**

The Design Development Committee had the opportunity to meet with Tom Westlund of Westlund Consultancy and Jesse Cain of Royal Construction Management to go over three schematic plan designs. During this meeting, members of the team discussed what plan was favored and what features we felt needed to be possibly changed or moved around. Tom Westlund then took our notes and feedback and reworked them into one schematic plan that the committee then reconvened and looked over again. At this meeting, we felt that it was better but there were still a few things to change. Carl Lippert (FLL board president) agreed that he would go over these changes with Tom Westlund but that he didn't feel Tom would have the time to make the changes before our upcoming August FLL board meeting. It is still our intent to discuss the schematic plan that we have settled on at this time with the rest of the FLL board at the August 14<sup>th</sup> meeting and see how they feel going forward. Discussion was also had about adding a small kitchenette in the new conference/meeting space and about what the outdoor space is specifically going to be (pavilion, gazebo, etc.) – it was felt that these needed to be board approved decisions, so they are on the August 14<sup>th</sup> agenda.

The Book House is now closed for book sales. Book sales continue to happen in the front vestibule of the log cabin library. We are not accepting any donations of books or materials at this time.

The plan for the Book House at this time is for Dave Popelka to move the Book House later this month. Almost all items have been cleared out of the house at this point in time.
