Library Expansion Plans and Progress

- The Forest Lodge Library Board of Trustees reviewed and approved a Vision Statement letter that was sent to the Cable Natural History Museum, as well as to the Towns of Cable and Namakagon. We have requested a meeting date to continue discussion on future needs and the lease agreement with the CNHM, hoping to have that scheduled in January. We are waiting to hear back from the CNHM on the time that works for their committee at this point. In accordance with WI State Statute 19.82 (1), this meeting will need to be open to the public. The agenda for this meeting will be properly posted in all areas that library meetings are usually displayed.
- The Forest Lodge Library Board of Trustees will be meeting with Westlund Consultancy and Royal Construction to discuss Library Expansion Design and legal requirements of land use permit on January 8th at 3PM.

- The 2025 library budget has been approved by the FLL Board of Trustees. Many thanks to the Budget Committee and to former director Kristine Lendved for their support and guidance during this process and helping me to complete it my first time.
